Camden is rewriting its planning policy to allow 2,000 flats at the O2 Centre.

Camden is rewriting its Local Plan to allow the O2 Centre to be demolished and replaced with up to 2,000 flats.

This would be tantamount to giving permission, as any objections on the basis of **over-development, 16-storey height, or loss of facilities would have to be ignored.**

But Camden has now delayed the decision under pressure from Conservative councillors.
